Protecting your personal data and your privacy is our first priority. For this reason, we adhere to the applicable data protection regulations, in particular the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the German Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG).

Due to continuous technological advancements in the area of telecommunications, it is necessary for us continually to adapt our data protection information in line with technical and organisational changes as well as changes to data protection laws. Visiting this website

If you merely visit this website, we do not collect any personal data, only the following information as standard:

- IP address of the visitor to the website
- Date and time of the visit
- URL accessed
- Following URL (if available)
- Browser ID

This information is analysed in anonymised form for statistical purposes only. The information is not used in any other way or shared with third parties.

Temporary cookies are used to facilitate navigation when individual pages are accessed. These cookies do not contain any personal data and expire again once the session has ended.



General information on the collection of personal data

You can contact us directly using the contact form provided on our website. We collect, process and use the information you provide to us using this form exclusively for processing your specific request. If you commission EUROSEARCH CONSULTANTS GmbH – hereinafter referred to only as "EUROSEARCH" – in relation to its core activities, arranging suitable positions, we process the personal data you have provided for this purpose, for example

- Last name, first name
- Date of birth
- Family status
- Address, telephone number, e-mail address
- Account details
- Documents describing your career path (CVs).

The processing is carried out in accordance with Article 6 (1) sentence 1a GDPR (i.e. based on your consent) or on the basis of Article 6 (1) sentence 1b GDPR (for the performance of a relevant contract). In the course of our business activities EUROSEARCH otherwise collects, processes and uses personal data for the purposes of initiating an employment relationship, managing services in relation to our business activities and establishing and maintaining contacts that are essential for our business activities. We have a legitimate interest in doing so within the meaning of Article 6 (1) sentence 1f GDPR. Apart from this, we of course process personal data to comply with our legal obligations; Article 6 (1) sentence 1c GDPR. If we also use your personal data for other purposes, we will inform you separately to this privacy statement.

Erasure

We erase personal data as soon as the purpose of storing it with your appropriate consent no longer applies and we are no longer required by provisions of German or European legislation, such as archiving obligations under commercial or tax law, to continue to store your personal data.
